



How to view completed milestones in GUS

- 1) Log in to GUS, and access the Student Center from the Home Page:



- 2) There are items on the right of the Student Center and Milestones is one of them. If a student has not completed any milestones, it will show "No Milestones" under the Milestone category:



3) If a student has completed any milestone, they will be displayed in the “Milestones” box.


