Notes: Reserve a spot using link in BB. Complete during M2 year.



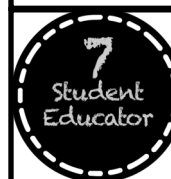
UNIV 16000 - Competence Practice Activity

Format/Event: Any activity where you are TEACHING others information relevant to your discipline. (ex: poster presentation)

Timeline: M3 Year

Course Association: During Residency Preparation 101

Notes: Requirements include submitting a reflection and verification form. These *should* be uploaded within 7 days of completing your educator activity. Example: Poster presentation, 3MT, health education booth at a health fair, etc. You can also sign up to be a student educator for an IPE event. (bridge, simulation, QAP, or Competence Workshop) to help co-facilitate with faculty.
